Any issues resulting from the MPW/MPAW value being exceeded are not covered by the warranty.

- The coupling ball has a pin where it connects to the bike carrier to prevent a trailer from being towed. Please be careful when installing and removing the bike carrier.

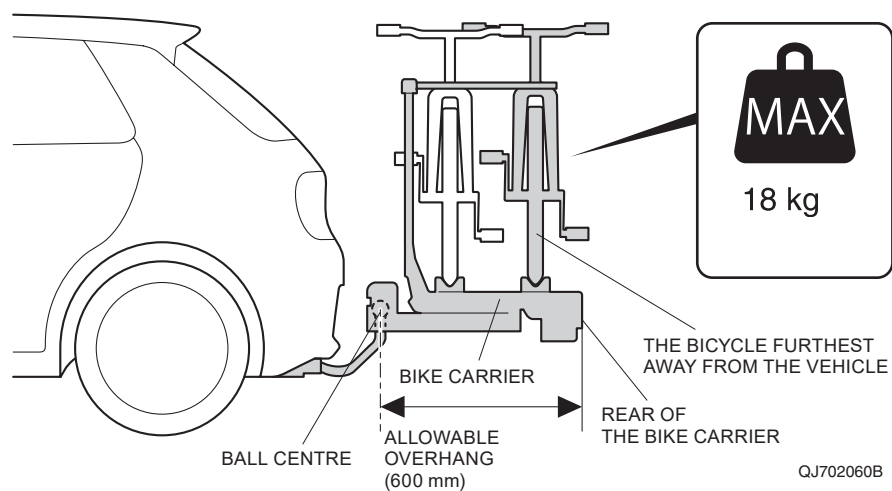
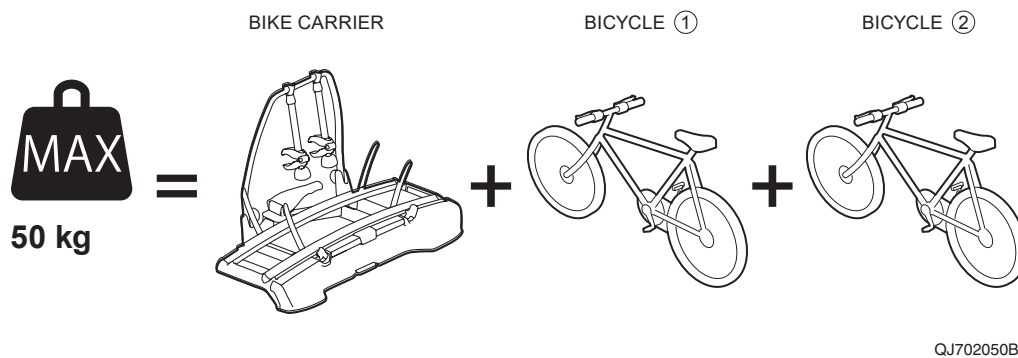


WARNING

- **Modifications to this product and its component parts are not permitted.**
- **Check the ball coupling and remove any dirt or oil before using this product.**
- **Check for any deformation or damage to the produce before use.**
- **After approximately 1000km (620 miles) of use, check the torque of the bolts and nuts of this product and retighten to the specified torque.**
- **Be careful not to exceed the load limit of the vehicle.**
- **Remove the detachable ball coupling key of this product before use.**
- **If the bike carrier attachment is not used, remove the ball coupling of this product.**
- **Before using an automatic car wash, remove the ball coupling of this product.**
- **Check that belts and other fasteners are secure and retighten if necessary.**
- **Immediately replace any damaged or worn parts.**
- **Before moving off, the function of the light bar lamps must be checked.**

Serious incidents may occur, such as a drop in the basic performance of the vehicle, damage to parts and dropping of load etc.

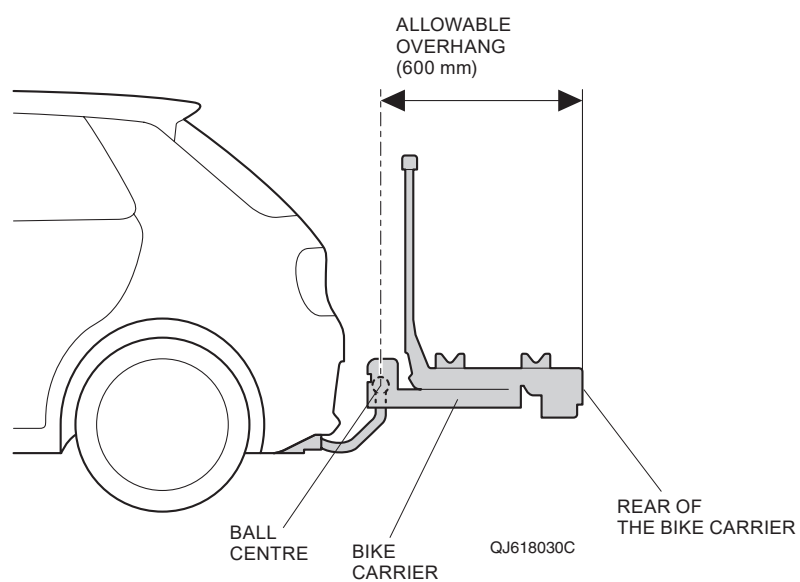
Precautions to Be Taken When Using the Bike Carrier

WARNING

- Do not exceed the maximum load weight of this product. The maximum number of bikes permitted when loaded is two. Please load the heavier bicycle on the side closest to the vehicle. The weight of the load on the side furthest away from the vehicle should be 18 kg or less.

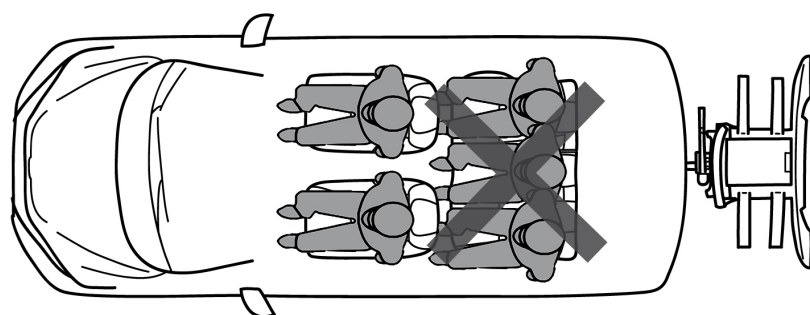
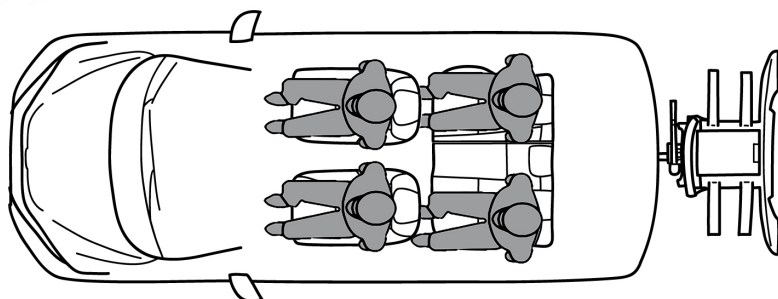
- Do not use the bike carrier when the overhang of the product exceeds the permitted amount.

- When using the bike carrier, no more than two passengers are permitted on the rear seats.

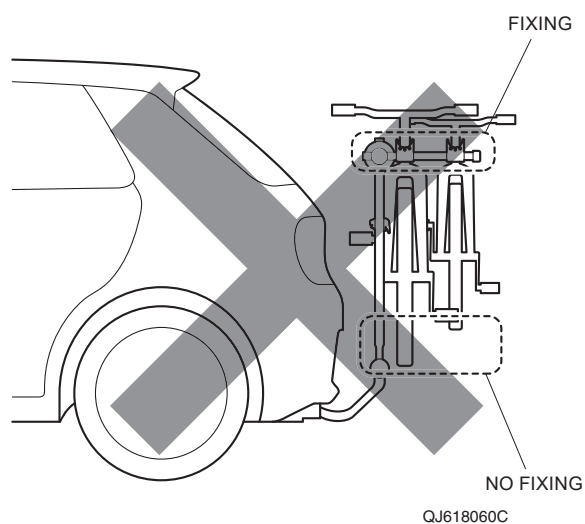
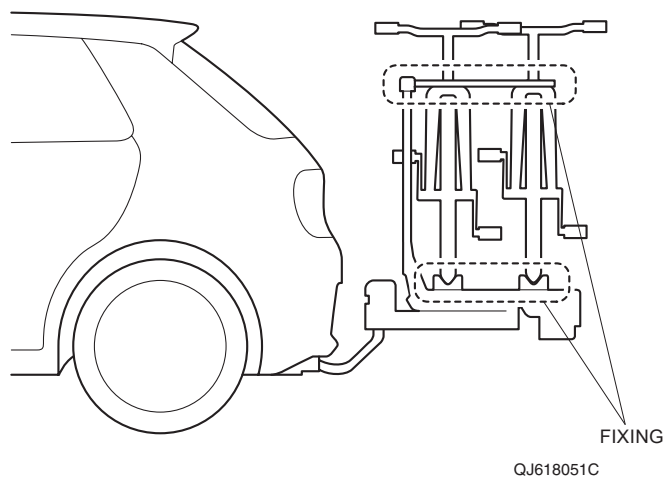

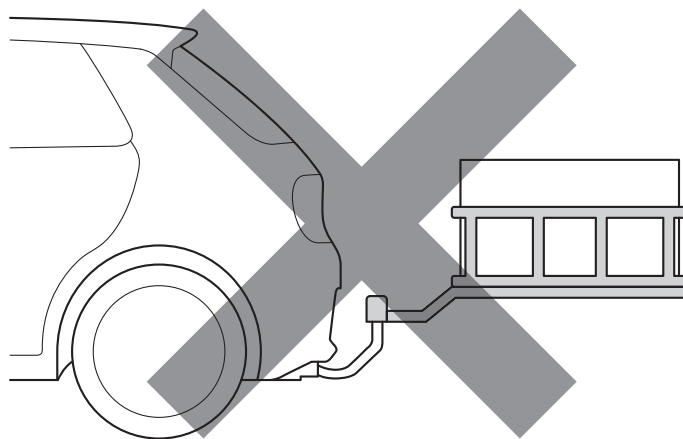
- Do not tow a trailer with this product. Do not use this product for any purpose other than using the bike carrier.

WARNING

- Do not use the bike carrier on rough roads or highly uneven roads.
- Please follow the instructions in the bike carrier Owner's Manual carefully.
- Make sure the ball coupling, bike carrier and loaded bike(s) are securely attached before use.
- When using the bike carrier, please drive with care as on-road behaviour may change.
- When using the bike carrier, please turn off the parking sensor and Blind Spot Information function on the vehicle. Please refer to the Owner's Manual of the vehicle for how to switch ON or OFF.
- Details of each safety function and Honda Parking Pilot can be found in the Owner's Manual of the vehicle (vehicle specifications).
- Please drive carefully when using the bike carrier as the Collision Mitigation Braking System function could be reduced.

Serious incidents may occur. For example, the vehicle function may be impaired or a collision may occur due to misrecognition of an obstacle etc. Serious incidents may occur, such as a collision with another vehicle, damage to the vehicle and parts and dropping of load etc.
